

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS,

I, the undersigned have legal custody of _____,

By signing this form, I understand that my child will be transported by a courtesy bus, provided by Northeast Financial Services, to and from various locations including Stoney Lake Bible Camp and Torch Trail Bible Camp on certain days. Furthermore, in the event of a minor medical emergency, I agree that a Staff Member of Tisdale Day Camps Inc. and/or the Camp Nurse at either Stoney Lake Bible Camp or Torch Trail Bible Camp can take whatever steps necessary to help remedy the situation. In the case of a more severe medical emergency, AND in the event that the Staff are not able to contact me FIRST, I hereby consent to and give my express written permission to Kent Little, and/or any full-time Staff Member of Tisdale Day Camps Inc., to obtain professional medical care for my child and I agree to pay for any costs incurred for such. I am also aware that some of the activities my child may participate in have inherent dangers and risks which may possibly result in injury, loss, or damage to persons or property.

I have read and understand this release agreement and I am aware that by signing this agreement I hereby release Tisdale Day Camp Inc., Stoney Lake Bible Camp, and Torch Trail Bible Camp, and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives, volunteer workers, and Northeast Financial Services/Kent Little (the foregoing being the releasees) from any and all liability and I am waiving certain legal rights which I or my heirs, next of Kin, executors, administrators, assigns or representatives may have against the releasees.
